- Participate in school activities.

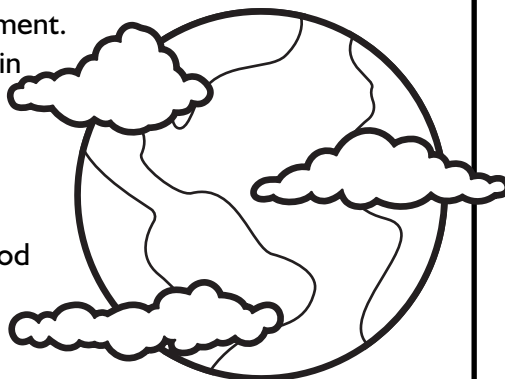
## HOW TO BE A GOOD CITIZEN IN YOUR COMMUNITY.
